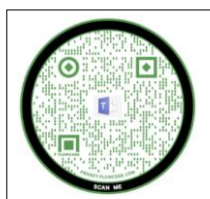

“Case Presentation: Complicated Obstetric Patient that was COVID Positive”

Objectives:

- Review the physiologic changes of pregnancy which occur in the term parturient.
- Review the general physiology of moderate to severe mitral stenosis, pulmonary hypertension and RV dysfunction and how normal maternal physiologic changes impacted the clinical course of the patient.
- Discuss how the care of this patient demonstrates the key concepts of reliability as the sum of system robustness and resilience in a multidisciplinary medical team.
