## "Congenital Cytomegalovirus (CMV): Targeted vs. Universal Screening in Newborns"

### **Objectives:**

- Understand the epidemiology and transmission of congenital CMV, including the impact of CMV infection on newborns.
- Identify the presentation of congenital CMV and long-term effects of congenital CMV in newborns, including neurodevelopmental outcomes and sensorineural hearing loss.
- Describe the diagnostic methods and screening methods for congenital CMV, including targeted vs. universal screening approaches.
- Discuss the management of congenital CMV during infancy, including roles and communication with the neonatal health care team.
