



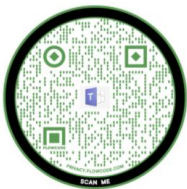

### “From the Voices of Black Dementia Caregivers: The Need for Culturally Responsive Education on Navigating Care”

- Discuss dementia-related disparities that exist in Black/African American communities.
  - Discuss the unique experiences of Black dementia caregivers.
- Identify steps to culturally tailor programs to address the needs of diverse dementia caregivers.
