- Identify indicators of substance use disorders (SUDs) in trauma patients by recognizing common clinical presentations, behavioral cues, and relevant screening results
- Explain key risk factors, warning signs, and clinical symptoms of post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD) as they present in the trauma care settings
- Describe the roles and responsibilities of interdisciplinary team members in the identification and management of substance use and trauma-related disorders
- Demonstrate motivational interviewing skills and unbiased communication practices in trauma-care settings
