“Myositis: More than Weakness”

Objectives:

- Define the clinical spectrum of idiopathic inflammatory myopathies, including typical patterns of muscle weakness, key extra-muscular manifestations, and major disease subtypes encountered in internal medicine practice.
- Apply a practical, stepwise approach to the evaluation of suspected myositis, including appropriate initial laboratory testing, autoantibody assessment, imaging, and pathologic evaluation, while distinguishing inflammatory myopathies from common mimics.
- Describe evidence-informed principles of myositis management, including the general role of glucocorticoids and steroid-sparing agents, emerging therapies, and the importance of multidisciplinary care.

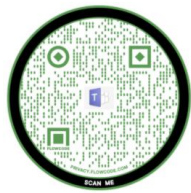
