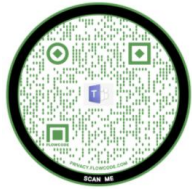

“Advancing the Standard of Nephrology Care with Renal Genetic Testing”

Objectives:

- Apply evidence-based criteria to identify patients with kidney disease who may benefit from genetic testing.
- Differentiate between pathogenic/likely pathogenic variants and variants of uncertain significance, and integrate these results into diagnostic refinement, risk stratification, therapeutic decision-making, and transplant planning.
