- Classify and risk-stratify CKD using a dual approach with eGFR and albuminuria (uACR)
- Implement the four pillars of evidence-based CKD pharmacotherapy — ACEI/ARB, SGLT2 inhibitor, GLP-1 receptor agonist and nonsteroidal MRA
- Apply statin therapy independent of lipid panel in CKD
- Optimize HTN and anemia treatment in CKD
- Identify nephrology referral indications beyond eGFR, including rapid eGFR decline, refractory albuminuria, and the need for disease-specific therapies.
