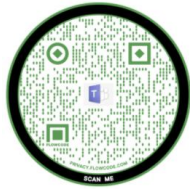

The Ethical Underpinnings of Informed Consent

Objectives:

- Discuss the definition of informed consent.
- Outline the pillars of informed consent from an ethical standpoint.
