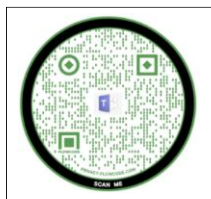

“Prevention and Management of Minimally Invasive Abdominal Entry Injuries”

Objectives:

- Plan safe abdominal access using preoperative imaging, prior surgical history, body habitus, and patient-specific anatomy.
